

INDEX MEDICUS BIBLIOGRAPHY

Medical literature prior to 1946 must be searched by hand through print indexes. This guide provides a description and time period covered by available indexes.

<u>1880-1961</u>	Index Catalogue of the Surgeon General's Office	Theses, books, and pamphlets listed under author and subject. Journal articles listed under subject only.
1880-1895	1 st Series	16 volumes, v2-bibliography, v.3-portraits, v. 10-periodicals by country, v.11 pharmacopeia by country, v. 13-societies, v. 15-listing of medical school and universities.
1896-1916	2 nd Series	21 volumes. Bibliography
1918-1932	3 rd Series	10 volumes, Entries for journal articles ceased with those for 1925. v. 10-incunabula.
1936-1955	4 th Series	11 volumes, through M. Picks up journal articles omitted from 3 rd series. V. 3 congresses of meetings to come. V. 11-large section on Military Medicine.
1959-1961	5 th Series	3 volumes, includes monographic items only (no serials) carrying 1950 or earlier imprint. 5 th series does not duplicate titles Army Medical Library Catalog.
<u>1948-1965</u>	National Library of Medicine Catalog (title varies)	Supplement to the Library of Congress Catalog. No subject approach before 1950.
1948-1951	Armed Medical Library Catalog	1950-54 cumulation supercedes annual volumes for 1950-53.
1952-1955	Armed Forces Medical Library Catalog	Produced by photo-offset reproduction of Medical Library catalog cards.
1956-1965	National Library of Medicine Catalog	
<u>1966-date</u>	NLM Current Catalog	Monthly, cumulated quarterly and annually, Covers monographs, no serial titles, and audio-visuals. Uses MeSH subject headings. Main entries give full cataloging.

<u>1879-1927</u>	Index Medicus (IM)	Scientific orientation. Current Did not include pharmacy, chemistry, veterinary medicine or dentistry.
1879-1899	Series I (billings)	Monthly, Indexed by subject and author, but not cumulated.
1903-1920	Series II (Billings, Carnegie)	Similar to series I War suppl. 1918.
1921-1927	Series III (Carnegie Corp.)	Quarterly, Not cumulated. Author index only.
1880-1961	Index Catalogue of the Library of the Surgeon-General's Office	Journal articles by subject only.
1916-1926	Quarterly Cumulative Index to Current Medical Literature	Each issue cumulates all previous entries for that year. Oriented toward English-speaking clinical on author-subject alphabet per volume. Contains govt. docs., research articles, some new books.
1927-1956	Quarterly Cumulative Index Medicus (QCIM)	Two volumes per year cumulated every 6 months. Indexing shared with NLM until 1932. Oriented toward clinical and highly selective of research communicated.
1941-1959	Current List of Medical Literature (Current List)	Monthly list, alphabetical by name of journal with each article numbered for indexing. Annual indexes by subject and author comprise Part 2 of each volume. This only subject-author index to medical journals published for the years 1957-1959.
1960-date	Index Medicus	Monthly (published by NLM)
	Cumulative Index Medicus	Annual (published by AMA, 1960-63, NLM, 1964-date). Compiled from MEDLARS tapes 1964to date;
